Subject: Referee Coaching Sightings 2010

Dear All,

In consultation with Head Coach Roger Drew, and the Coaching panel, the ARRA is going to trial a different way of viewing refereeing performances in 2010.

The guiding principle is this will be referee driven as opposed to last year being coach driven.

Every referee in the JRC/SS and C panel has been allocated a referee coach. This list can be viewed in our Education section. It will be added to and changed no doubt. It also has some B panel referees "assisting us" with sightings – I trust you can all help.

It will be up to each referee to "drive" their own sightings by contacting their allocated coach to come out and see them. It is envisaged that each referee will be seen at least twice this season.

We will monitor sightings on a weekly basis to ensure no-one is being missed.

B panel referees and Premier referees will be seen by the ARRA selectors via the usual channel.

Coaches – while you will have your own charges to view, you also have agreed to take on the 3-4 extra referees to view at least twice during the year. If you so happen to be at a ground to view one of these referees and another referee is on an adjoining ground or has a game before /after the referee you are watching and there is no coach present, the guiding principle is that you will also view the "other" referee and submit a report on RRIMs on them as well.

We will review this programme regularly but in theory it should work. It will need coaches communicating to us where they will be on Saturdays. I suspect there will be several coaches at the same ground on Saturdays but if we all pick up on who we are supposed to view then no-one is going to miss out.

If anyone has any issues please do not hesitate to sing out. More than happy to help you all.
